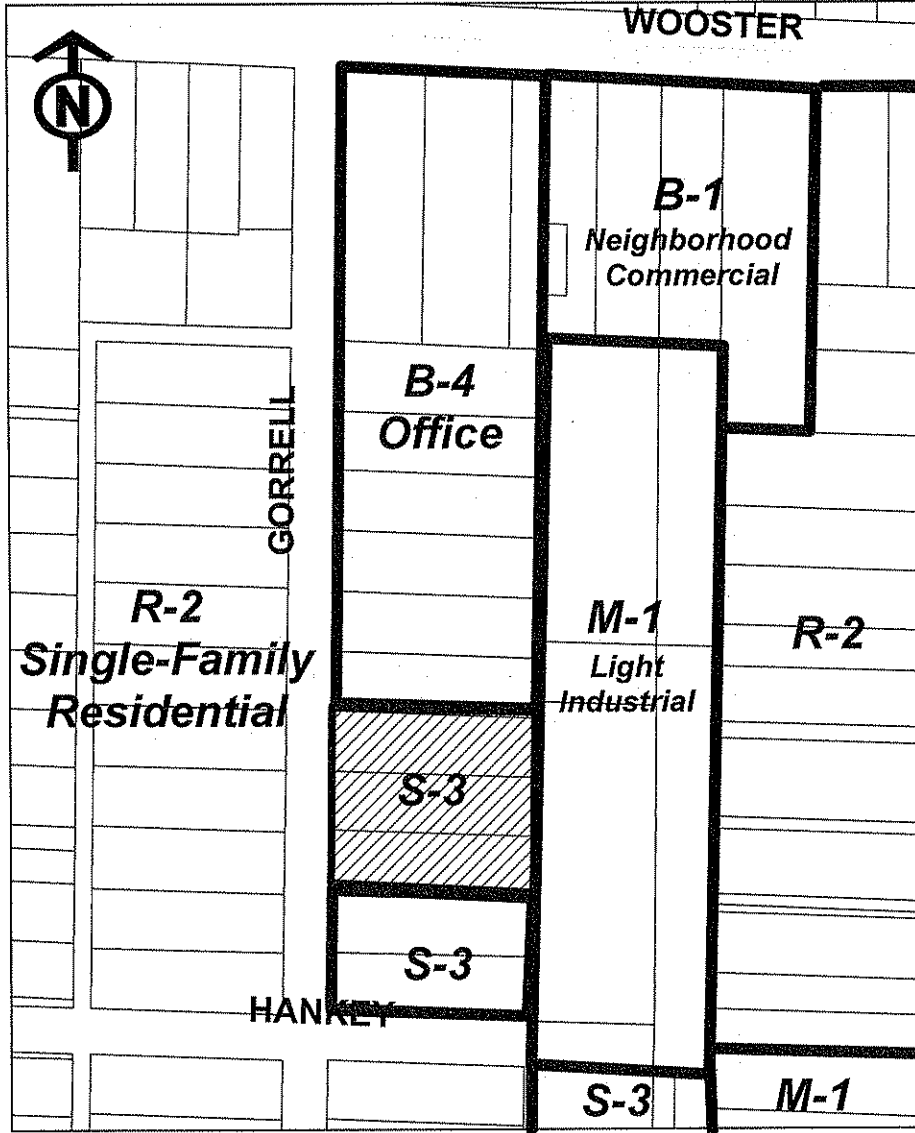

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 93.01, SECTION 93.14(A), SECTION 93.99 AND
SECTION 150.69 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO
TO DELETE REFERENCE TO BOCA**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the title of Section 93.01 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended and adopted to delete reference to BOCA and to read as follows:

SECTION 93.01 OHIO FIRE CODES, ADOPTED; ENFORCEMENT

SECTION 2: That Section 93.14(A) is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 93.14 FIRE LANES AUTHORIZED; PARKING REGULATED

(A) Under the authority granted by Section 93.01, the Fire Chief has the right and authority under the Ohio Fire Code to establish fire lanes even upon private property in commercial mall areas and shall have the right to prohibit parking in any designated fire lanes as designated by the Fire Chief.

SECTION 3: That Section 93.99(A) is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 93.99 PENALTY

(A) Any person who violates any of the provisions of the Ohio Fire Code adopted by § 93.01 or fails to comply therewith, or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order made thereunder, or who shall build in violation of any detailed statement of specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, and from which no appeal has been taken, or who shall fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by Council or by a court of competent jurisdiction, within the time fixed herein, shall severally for each such violation or noncompliance be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$100. The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue; all such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time. When not otherwise specified, each ten days that prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The application of such penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

SECTION 4: That Section 150.69 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 150.69 CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

All signs erected under this chapter shall be constructed in accordance with the Ohio Building Code as adopted.




