**ORDINANCE CERTIFYING UNPAID COST OF SNOW
REMOVAL TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR
PLACEMENT ON THE TAX DUPLICATE**

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and Ohio Revised Code Section 701.05 grants assessment authority; and

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances requires property owners to clear snow on premises within 24 hours after the abatement of any storm during which such snow and ice may have accumulated; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director, for two weeks prior to January 1 of each year, published this determination in the newspaper of local circulation to notify property owners to regularly clean and keep all sidewalks abutting their premises free and clear of snow and ice within 24 hours after the abatement of any storm during which such snow and ice may have accumulated during the ensuing months of the year. Should any such snow and ice be found within the city, the Public Works Director may cause these sidewalks to be cleaned at the expense of the city;

WHEREAS, certain property owners failed to clear the snow within the required time requiring the City to remove the same at the cost of the City; and

WHEREAS, the property owners upon demand have refused to reimburse the City of Bowling Green for the cost of such services;

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has certified such costs to the Council for certification to the Wood County Auditor to place on the tax duplicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the amounts be certified to the Wood County Auditor for the parcels represented on the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof and be placed on the tax duplicate for the year 2010.

SECTION 2: The Finance Director is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the Wood County Auditor so that such sums can be placed on said tax duplicate.

Ordinance No. 7996 Passed April 5, 2010

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COMMENCEMENT OF LEGAL PROCEEDINGS TO APPROPRIATE VARIOUS PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY INTERESTS IN CERTAIN PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF WIDENING NORTH MAIN STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO; AUTHORIZING THE DEPOSIT OF FUNDS WITH THE COURT

Whereas, the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Wood County, Ohio previously adopted Resolution No. 3426 declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate various permanent and temporary interests in certain property for the purpose of widening North Main Street; and

Whereas, the City is attempting to come to agreements with the owners and others having interests in the property concerning the amount of compensation to be paid; however, it may be necessary to commence formal legal proceedings if agreements cannot be reached.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The Council hereby authorizes the commencement of all necessary legal proceedings to appropriate the necessary permanent and temporary interests in property for the purpose of widening North Main Street, from Dill Avenue to Newton Road, total length being approximately 1.1 miles, including widening E. Poe Road and W. Poe Road adjacent to N. Main Street to accommodate additional turn lanes and necessary related work.

Section 2: A description of each parcel of property, the names of the owners and other persons with interests of record, the interests to be appropriated, and the amount the City has determined to be the fair market value of the interests being appropriated are set forth in the Exhibit A which is on file with the Clerk of Council and which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3: If the City and the owners and other persons with interests of record in the various parcels are unable to agree concerning the amount of compensation to be paid, then the special legal counsel is authorized to commence all necessary legal proceedings and to deposit with the court or courts having jurisdiction the amount of money the City has determined to be the fair market value of the interests being acquired, and the damages to the residue, if any, and thereupon the City shall take immediate possession of the subject property.

Section 4: All formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.



SECTION 3: That by entering into a contract with the service provider, the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to pay the service provider under such contract with funds from the Ohio Department of Transportation Rural Transit Program Grant and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant for transportation service for the Bowling Green Transit Program.



**ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING THE
 S-2 SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
 FOR THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO,
 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the second supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted since the recodification of the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make reference to sections of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the law of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the second supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Such supplement shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and ordered to insert such supplement into the copy of the Code of Ordinances kept on file in the Office of the Clerk.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.




