

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTION 38.02(A)
 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING
 GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING CIVIL INFRACTIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 38.02(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:


SECTION 38.02 CLASSIFICATION OF CIVIL OFFENSES

(A) Class A Civil Offenses. A person who violates a standard of conduct set forth in a section or chapter of the Bowling Green Codified Ordinances listed below is liable for the civil fine specified in § 38.99 for a Class A Civil Offense. If a person has previously been found to have violated the same provision of the Bowling Green Codified Ordinances within one year that person may be charged as a second offender and on being found to have committed a second or subsequent offense is liable for the civil fine specified in § 38.99 for the first violation of a Class B Civil Offense.



ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF DEFERRAL ACCOUNTING FOR CREATION OF A REGULATORY ASSET OR LIABILITY TO RECORD CHARGES OR CREDITS THAT WOULD HAVE OTHERWISE BEEN RECORDED IN EQUITY TO MEET DEBT COVENANTS, PURSUANT TO THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING STANDARD (FAS) 71, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Public Utilities is hereby authorized to use deferral accounting for creation of a regulatory asset or liability to record charges or credits that would have otherwise been recorded in equity to meet debt covenants, pursuant to the Financial Accounting Standard (FAS) 71.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that it is necessary for the accounting procedure to be in place prior to the end of the calendar year in order for the Board of Public Utilities adequate time to determine its use for 2009, thereby protecting the peace, safety, and well-being of the citizens.
