





**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 93.99(A) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO,
REGARDING FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 93.99(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 93.99 PENALTY

(A) Any person who violates any of the provisions of the BOCA Fire Code adopted by § 93.01 or fails to comply therewith, or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order made thereunder, or who shall build in violation of any detailed statement of specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, and from which no appeal has been taken, or who shall fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by Council or by a court of competent jurisdiction, within the time fixed herein, shall severally for each such violation or noncompliance be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 for each offense. Each and every day during which prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue; all such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time. When not otherwise specified, each ten days that prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The application of such penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

SECTION 2: All other portions of Section 93.99 remain unchanged.

SECTION 1: That Section 38.02(B) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of
Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 38.02 CLASSIFICATION OF CIVIL OFFENSES

(B) Class B Civil Offenses. A person who violates a standard of
conduct set forth in a section or chapter of the Bowling Green Codified
Ordinances listed below is liable for the civil fine specified in § 38.99 for a Class
B Civil Offense. If the provision is listed below, the otherwise applicable civil
fine is reduced by 75% if the person charged shows in accordance with § 38.04
that the violation has been corrected. If a person has previously been found to
have violated the same provision of the code within one year that person may
be charged as a second offender and on being found to have committed a
second or subsequent offense is liable for the civil fine specified in § 38.99 for
the offense provided below, which fine is not subject to reduction for correction
of the violation.

fine is reduced by 75% if the person charged shows in accordance with § 38.04
that the violation has been corrected. If a person has previously been found to
have violated the same provision of the Bowling Green Codified Ordinances
within one year that person may be charged as a second offender and on being

found to have committed a second or subsequent offense is liable for the civil fine specified in § 38.99 for the offense provided below, which fine is not subject to reduction for correction of the violation.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF LOAN AGREEMENT AND EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF PROMISSORY NOTE.

WHEREAS, American Municipal Power ("AMP") and the City of Bowling Green (the "City") wish to cooperate in connection with financing improvements to the City's electric system, including acquiring real estate for the future use of the City's municipal electric system (the "Project");

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Bowling Green, State of Ohio, hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary to borrow the amount of not to exceed \$600,000 for the purpose of providing interim financing for the Project. Such amount shall be borrowed from AMP, shall be repayable solely from the net revenues of the electric system and otherwise on the terms and conditions set forth in the Loan Agreement and Promissory Note authorized in Section 2 hereof and attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver, on behalf of the City, a Loan Agreement and Promissory Note substantially in the form of the Loan Agreement and Promissory Note attached to this Ordinance and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. That the Promissory Note is secured by the revenues of the City's municipal electric system on a parity basis with the City's obligation to AMP dated September 11, 1998 (City of Bowling Green Project -- Phase I); its obligation to AMP dated December 4, 1997 (City of Bowling Green Project -- Phase II); its obligation to AMP dated September 24, 1998 (City of Bowling Green Real Estate Acquisition Project); its obligation to AMP dated September 9, 1999 (City of Bowling Green CBD Revitalization and 69KV Transmission Line Project); and its obligation to AMP dated September 8, 2000 (City of Bowling Green 69KV Northern Loop Extension Project).

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

ORDINANCE DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS, WITH GENERAL ELECTRIC INTERNATIONAL, INC., FOR THE REPAIR AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF A 7.5 MVA STATION POWER TRANSFORMER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That a real and present emergency is hereby declared, and the Utilities Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with General Electric International, Inc., for purposes of repair and/or replacement of a 7.5 MVA station power transformer, without advertising for competitive bids.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure.
