IV. Income Tax Issues and Deposit of Funds

A. Income Tax

The City levies a 1.92% income tax. The City income tax collection administration is paid from the income tax revenues before any distribution. After covering administrative costs and tax refunds, the base tax amount of 1.5% is distributed in the following manner:

1. 50% to the General Fund;
2. 33-1/3% for Sewer and Water Capital Improvement Fund;
3. 8-1/3% to the Capital Improvement Fund;
4. 5% for the Street Repair Fund;
5. 3-1/3% for Park, Playground and Recreation Fund.

The .42% balance is credited directly to the Police Levy Fund and Fire Levy Fund and is distributed in the following manner:

1. .14% for up to 14 additional permanent police officers for the Police Division;
2. .09% for up to 8 additional permanent firefighters for the Fire Division;
3. .19% for at least 19 additional permanent firefighters for the Fire Division.

B. Interest Distribution

1. With limited exceptions, interest earned on all governmental funds shall be credited to the City's General Fund. The City's Interest policy addresses the exceptions.
- ~~2. All Utility interest earned based on cash balances available in the various electric, water, and sewer related funds will be credited to their respective revenue fund.~~

ORDINANCE ADOPTING SECTION 95.01(D), AND AMENDING SECTION 95.03(A), AND ADOPTING SECTION 95.13(G) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, AS AMENDED AND PRESENTLY WRITTEN, INCREASING THE RATE OF MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX BY 0.08 PERCENT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010, AND EFFECTIVE THROUGH AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2012, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE GENERAL FUND, AND PROVIDING FOR THE FORM OF BALLOT LANGUAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 95.01(D) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, is hereby adopted as follows:

(D) Of the Municipal Income Tax rate, 0.08 percent shall be solely to provide funds for the General Fund.
(remaining portions of Section 95.01 remain unchanged)

SECTION 2: That Section 95.03(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted as follows:

(A) Taxable Income. Subject to the provisions of 95.15 of this Chapter, an annual tax for the purposes specified in Section 95.01 shall be imposed on and after January 1, 2010, at the rate of 1.5 percent per annum for the purposes specified in 95.01; 0.14 percent for the purposes described in Section 95.01; at the rate of 0.09 percent for the purposes described in Section 95.01; at the rate of 0.19 percent for the purposes described in Section 95.01; and at the rate of 0.08 percent for the purposes described in Section 95.01(D) upon the following:
(remaining portions of Section 95.03 remain unchanged)

SECTION 3: That Section 95.13(G) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is hereby adopted as follows:


(G) Funds collected under the provisions of Section 95.01(D) shall be deposited for General Fund purposes as determined by City Council from time to time.
(remaining portions of Section 95.13 remain unchanged)


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2010, subject to the approval of the electors of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, as provided in Section 718.01 of the Revised Code of Ohio. It is the desire of this Council that the ballots presented to the electors of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, at the General Election on November 3, 2009, shall be in substantially the following form:






