**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FORMULA PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance administers financial assistance for local government to assist those impacted by the recession and to stabilize state and local government budgets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green seeks financial assistance from the Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program: Local Solicitation, to purchase necessary equipment for the Police Division;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance to administer a grant to implement said program, and the Mayor is authorized to sign said agreement.


SECTION 2: The Council hereby certifies that the City of Bowling Green, Ohio has the legal authority to apply for and accept an offer of grant funding.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.






WHEREAS, the B. G. Transit/City of Bowling Green is the transit operator for the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and;


WHEREAS, the B. G. Transit/City of Bowling Green is presently providing transit service and observing all federal and state rules regarding these programs.



**ORDINANCE ABOLISHING SECTION 75.06 AND AMENDING AND ADOPTING REVISIONS TO SECTIONS 75.07 AND 75.28 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING BICYCLES, MOTORCYCLES AND SNOWMOBILES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That portions of Chapter 75 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, are hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**Chapter 75: Bicycles, Motorcycles and Snowmobiles**

Section 75.06 – *Reserved.*

Section 75.07 Lights and Reflector on Bicycle; Brakes.

- (A) No person shall operate or move a bicycle upon a roadway or sidewalk under the conditions specified in §74.03, unless it is equipped with the following:
  - (1) A headlight emitting a white light on the front;
  - (2) A taillight or reflector emitting a red light on the rear, which shall be of such size and characteristics and so displayed and maintained as to be visible from all distances within 500 feet of such bicycle;
  - (3) An essentially colorless reflector on the front of a type approved by the Director;
  - (4) Reflectors or reflective tire sidewalls shall be placed on the sides of the bicycle. Each reflector shall be visible on each side of the wheel from a distance of 600 feet when directly in front at lawful lower beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle.
- (B) Bicycles shall be equipped with brakes which stop a bike moving at 10 miles per hour within 15 feet.


Section 75.28 Sale and Transfer.


It shall be the duty of every person who sells or transfers ownership of any bicycle or motorized bicycle to report such sale or transfer to the Police Division, if the person has had his or her bicycle or motorized bicycle licensed. That person will furnish the Police Division with the name and address of the person to whom the bicycle or motorized bicycle was sold or transferred. That person will also give the registration card to the person receiving the bicycle or motorized bicycle. This report shall be made by the person selling or transferring within five days of the date of the sale or transfer.

Section 75.28(B) shall be eliminated.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


