SECTION 1: That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to petition  
the Board of County Commissioners of Wood County, Ohio, to change  
township lines for Bowling Green and Center Township and for Plain  
Township in order to conform the township lines with the limits of the City of  
Bowling Green corporation, and so as to incorporate all annexations that  
may have taken place since the creation of "Bowling Green Township" in  
accordance with Section 503.07 of the Ohio Revised Code.

RESOLUTION NAMING THE TUCKER WOODS

WHEREAS, Mrs. Margaret Tucker has been the driving force behind the six-year effort to purchase the 19.6 acres woodland property and add it to the existing Wintergarden/St. John's Nature Preserve park; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Tucker has exhibited outstanding leadership in the effort to fund the purchase of this property, first as President of the Bowling Green Parks and Recreation Foundation, and then as Campaign Chair for the "Save the Woods" fund-raising campaign which has reached \$385,000 in donations thus far; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Tucker has also provided decades of support and commitment to Bowling Green's parks by serving on the Parks and Recreation Board, the BG Parks and Recreation Foundation Board and numerous event and fundraising committees; and


WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to recognize Mrs. Tucker's decades of support and commitment to the Bowling Green Parks and Recreation programs and facilities, and has decided that the woodland property added to the Wintergarden/St. John's Nature Preserve be named the *Tucker Woods* in honor of Margaret Tucker and her late husband, Duane Tucker.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING  
SECTION 35.03, SECTION 35.04 AND SECTION 35.05(D)  
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF  
BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, REGARDING FUNDS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 35.03, Section 35.04 and Section 35.05(D) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio are hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

**Section 35.03 Water Capital Reserve Fund and Water Depreciation Fund**

A fund to be known as the Water Capital Reserve Fund and a fund to be known as the Water Depreciation Fund are created. These funds shall be used only for the purpose of making extensions, betterments, repairs, or additions to the water works system of the city. The funds shall have in them the monies now carried in a fund under the same title, and any other funds which Council may cause to be transferred to them in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 35.04 Sewer Capital Reserve Fund and Sewer Depreciation Fund**

There is established in the city a fund to be known as the Sewer Capital Reserve Fund and a fund to be known as the Sewer Depreciation Fund. These funds shall be used only for the purpose of constructing additions or replacements to the existing sewage system of the city. The funds shall have in them monies transferred to them from other funds in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, and also funds collected by special assessment to repay the cost of improvements previously financed from these funds.

**Section 35.05 Electric System Depreciation Fund and Capital Reserve Fund**

Section D is hereby eliminated. All remaining portions of Section 35.05 remain unchanged.


SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


