





ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE BOWLING GREEN CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU FOR THE PROMOTION AND PUBLICIZING OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, TO BRING THE PATRONAGE AND BUSINESS OF CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, RELIGIOUS, PROFESSIONAL AND SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS INTO THE CITY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY AND THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY THEREOF, AND AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF 55% OF THE REVENUE GENERATED BY THE HOTEL-MOTEL TAX FOR SAID PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, on the 19th day of May, 1980, adopted Ordinance No. 3606 whereby the City imposed a transient occupancy (hotel-motel) tax, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and the citizens thereof that the Bowling Green Convention & Visitors Bureau promote and publicize the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, for the purpose of bringing the patronage and business of various organizations into the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, for the benefit of the citizens thereof, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, deems it advisable to use the equivalent of 55% of the revenues generated from the transient occupancy (hotel-motel) tax for said purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:


SECTION 1: That it is necessary to contract for professional services for the purpose of bringing the patronage and business of various organizations into the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, for the benefit of the citizens thereof.

SECTION 2: That the Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Bowling Green Convention & Visitors Bureau, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part thereof, for the purposes of retaining the services of the Bowling Green Convention & Visitors Bureau for the promotion and publicizing of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, for the further purpose of bringing the patronage and business of cultural, educational, religious, professional and sports organizations into the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, and the business community thereof.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


