

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 152.20(G) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO,
RELATING TO BIOFUEL BURNERS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 152.20(G) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

SECTION 152.20 NUISANCE CONDITIONS PROHIBITED

(G) Conduct any business which generates noxious odors, smoke, dust or dirt which are harmful to public health; operate any apparatus constituting a biofuel burner which generates or emits odors, smoke or dust, but excluding any properly maintained biofuel burner already in place and operating as of the effective date of this ordinance. Biofuel burner shall be defined as an exterior device, structure, or apparatus, which supplies direct or indirect heat from the burning of a solid fuel, including, but not limited to, wood, corn, biomass pellets and other solid biofuels, to the structure. Traditional wood burning stoves and fireplaces are excepted.
