TO THE FEE FOR PROCESSING AN
S-DISTRICT SITE PLAN**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 150.40(D) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

Section 150.40 S-1, S-2, S-3, S-4, and S-5 Planned Development

(D) Fees. In order to partially defray the costs of processing an S-District site plan, a fee of **\$300** must accompany the site plan. This fee is non-refundable and will be deposited in the general fund.

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING SECTIONS 150.03 AND 150.33(B) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, CONCERNING AGRICULTURAL ANIMALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 150.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted so as to provide for the definition of "agricultural animals" in accordance with the following:

Section 150.03 Definitions

Agricultural animals. Animals normally associated with agriculture including, but not limited to, cattle, goats, horses, poultry, rabbits, sheep, and swine. Agricultural animals are only permitted in the A-1 Agricultural District. Domestic dogs and cats are not agricultural animals, but household pets.

SECTION 2: That Section 150.33(B) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

Section 150.33 A-1Agricultural

- B. Permitted uses. A building or lot within the A-1 District may be used only for the following purposes:
1. Farm residence and farm buildings.
 2. Any agricultural use. Agricultural use includes general farming, livestock and poultry raising, riding stables and academies, dairying, **agricultural animals**, but does not include animal processing or any manufacturing process.

SECTION 1: That Section 33.09(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:


Section 33.09 Fire Division Composition

(A) Employees of the Fire Division shall consist of one Fire Chief, one Fire Deputy Chief, and an unspecified number of Captains, Lieutenant-Emergency Medical Technicians, and Firefighter-Emergency Medical Technicians, as determined by the Mayor. Other classifications within the Fire Division shall include a secretary.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADOPTING
SECTION 33.08(A) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, RELATING
TO POLICE DIVISION COMPOSITION**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 33.08(A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, is hereby amended and adopted to read as follows:

Section 33.08 Police Division Composition

- (A) The classified civil service employees in the competitive class in the Police Division shall consist of the Chief, a Police Deputy Chief, **and an unspecified number of Lieutenants, Sergeants, and Police Officers**, as determined by the Mayor. Other job classifications within the Police Division shall include animal control officer, parking services technician, dispatcher, and secretary. The regular weekly working hours for all regular Police Division personnel below the rank of Police Deputy Chief shall be 40 hours weekly, unless negotiated otherwise in a collective bargaining agreement. For time worked in excess of 40 hours weekly, overtime pay shall be paid as provided in the current labor contracts, or other city policies, whichever is applicable. New appointees in the Police Division shall be trainees on probation for a period of one year.

WHEREAS, representatives of the City of Bowling Green and representatives of the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, have negotiated a contract, and

WHEREAS, the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, has ratified said contract;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to sign and enter into a contract with the Bowling Green Police Patrolman's Association OPBA, said contract being on file in the Personnel Department of the City of Bowling Green.
