
**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY



ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR THE UTILITIES DIRECTOR TO SEEK BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR STREET AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, STREET LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS, AERIAL UTILITY WORK, AND OTHER SERVICES RELATING TO IMPROVEMENTS ON EAST WOOSTER STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1: That the Municipal Administrator and/or the Director of Utilities is hereby authorized to seek bids and enter into a contract or contracts for street and sidewalk improvements, street lighting improvements, aerial utility work, and other services relating to improvements on East Wooster Street in the area between Prospect Street and the railroad tracks in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Municipal Administrator.

SECTION 2: That the Municipal Administrator is authorized to sign agreements with and work in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation to the extent applicable under the Local Project Administration program.






