


WHEREAS, this Council desires to publicly recognize Mr. Heminger for his many important contributions to local quality of life and for his dedicated and faithful service as an elected official.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:




RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF (A) PROPOSAL(S) AND/OR (AN) APPLICATION(S) WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) OF 2009 GRANT THROUGH THE US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA), AS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL TRANSIT LAWS, AS CODIFIED, 49 USC SECTION 5311, AND EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UPON GRANT PROPOSAL AND/OR APPLICATION APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a public transportation program;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF CITY BOWLING GREEN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) proposal(s) and/or (an) application(s) on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio, with the Ohio Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects pursuant to 49 USC Section 5311 and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute and file with such proposals and/or applications and assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal and/or application for the program of projects submitted to FTA.

SECTION 4: That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection to any procurement made as part of the project.

SECTION 5. That the Mayor of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio is authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City of Bowling Green, Ohio with the Ohio Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of operating and capital assistance projects.
